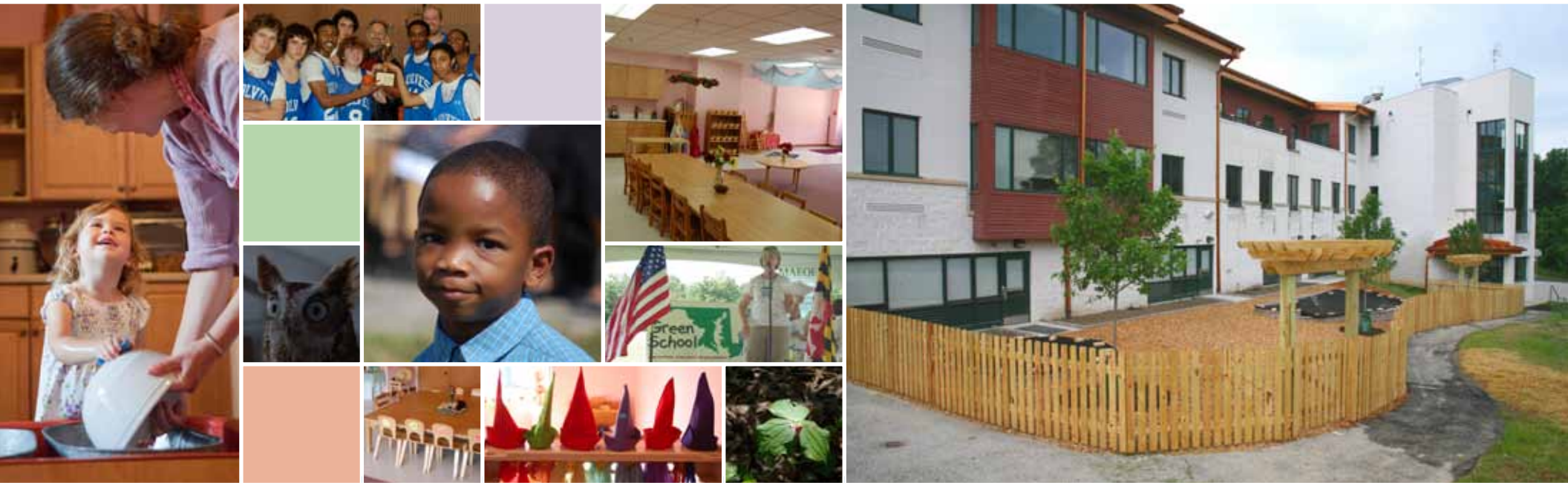

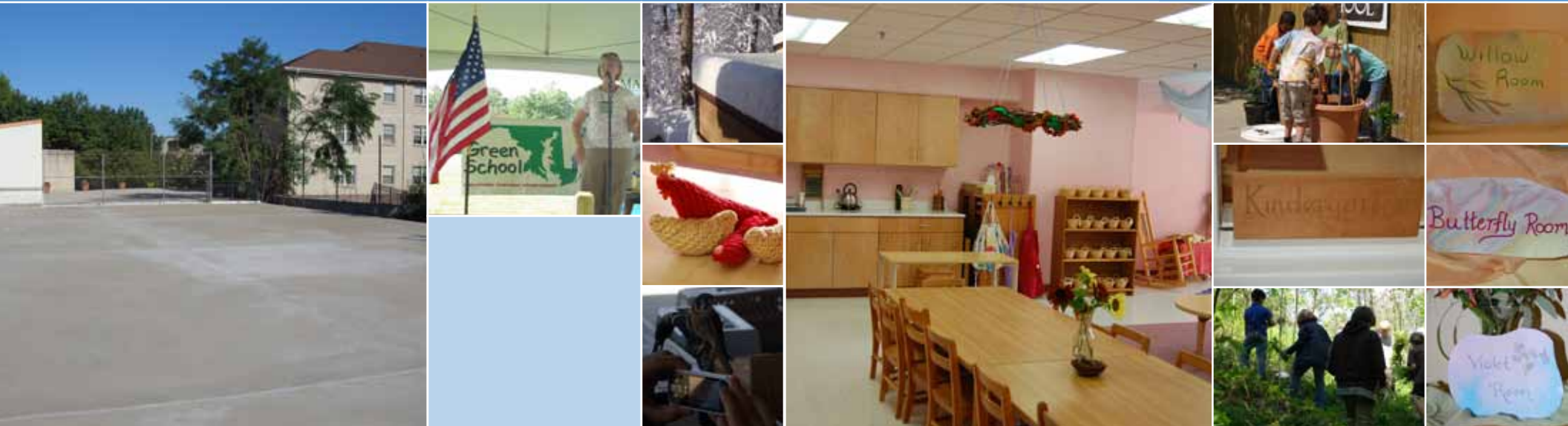

LETTER FROM OUR BOARD PRESIDENT



The most important accomplishment of the 2009-2010 school year was continuing to provide an excellent education—rooted in the Waldorf philosophy—while preparing the way for future growth. In our classrooms, teachers nurtured and educated our students with wisdom and skill. Below them, new classrooms were being constructed. The Children’s Garden enjoyed its final year in the Yellowwood Building, and the Upper School planned for future expansion throughout the entire Yellowwood Building.

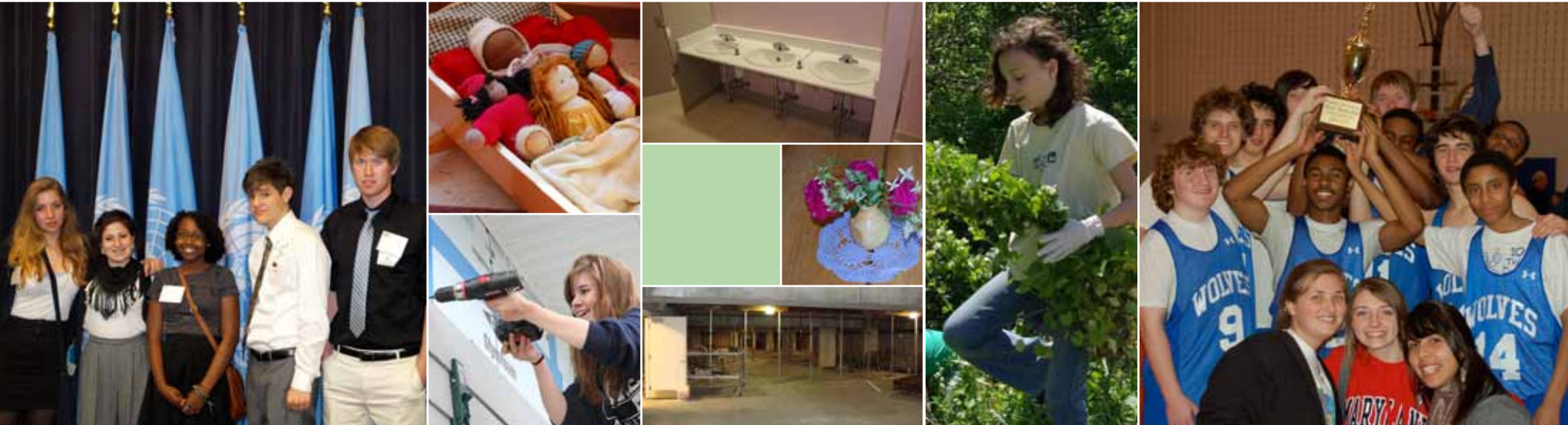
The construction of the new Children’s Garden is a highlight of the year. Four new classrooms, spacious and filled with light, were built in the Garden Level of the Tamarind Building. With a new kitchen, office, and storage areas, the new facility is ready to house a full Children’s Garden program. Chuck Andrade led a team of volunteers in Lazure painting the space. The new Children’s Garden brings promise and vision to the whole school. As children grow older they will literally move up, floor by floor, until they are ready to cross the field to the Upper School, which will have its own building and identity.

The exposed pad adjacent the Tamarind Building was waterproofed for additional assembly and

recreational space. In one of our first uses of the space, the eighth grade graduation ceremony and reception were held there on a beautiful June afternoon. We are grateful to all who made these building projects possible through their donations of time, work, and funds.

Our commitment to the environment was strengthened by our selection as a Maryland Green School. Various members of our school community attended the awards ceremony in June, including two Upper School students who accepted the award for our school, provided musical interludes, and made a presentation at one of the breakout sessions held after the ceremony. A tremendous amount of work was accomplished by the

faculty, staff, students, and members of the Green Steering Committee to submit our application for Green School status. Everyone can be proud of this achievement.

In support of both our environmental efforts and involvement as a UNESCO-Associated school, the entire community participated in World Water Day on March 22, 2010 with stories for younger children and an assembly, projects, and a speaker for older students. Students in the fifth, sixth, and seventh grades made drawings addressing water conservation to display by the faucets throughout both school buildings.

Our International Student Program in the Upper School continued to build this year. Eleven international students joined our Upper School for varying lengths of time throughout the 2009-2010 school year. The students came from Argentina, Peru, Spain, Italy, Germany, Switzerland, and Russia. Four of our own students visited Spain during the year, as well.

On March 27, 2010 our community came alive with the sounds and rhythms of wonderful music. Our own students served as the opening act for the Paul Levin Memorial Concert, held every other year to raise funds to support the music program. The concert featured *O'Malley's March*, whose members include Governor Martin O'Malley. Approximately 180 people enjoyed the performance, one of the largest crowds to attend a school-sponsored concert. It brought together many current members of the school community along with alumni, alumni parents, and friends of the school and of Paul Levin. Governor O'Malley spoke often about Paul Levin, a founding teacher of the school, and about the Waldorf School of Baltimore and the importance of its mission. Of Paul, Governor O'Malley said, "If you save one life, it's as if you saved the world. Paul saved the world many times over." Of the school, acknowledging our achievement of adding the twelfth grade for 2010-2011, he said, "Paul's spirit lives at the Waldorf School with every graduating class."

Alumni returned as well for an Alumni Open House on June 18, 2010. Held in the new Children's Garden, the event was a time of re-connecting with one another and catching up with all that is happening at the Waldorf School of Baltimore. We also launched our own Facebook page as a way of sharing news and connecting with our wider community.

To cap the year, our Upper School boys' basketball team won the Chesapeake Athletic Conference championship. We congratulate the coach and small, but dedicated, team!

Poised to graduate our first twelfth grade class in June, 2011, the Waldorf School of Baltimore is fulfilling its vision of *providing a quality, comprehensive nursery through twelfth grade Waldorf education* in Baltimore.
