

Student Health Forms School Year 2011 -2012

State and City mandates require medical and emergency forms to be on file in the school office before your child may attend school. The Department of Health & Mental Hygiene states that children must be suspended if their records are not in compliance by the first day of school. All health forms must be returned by August 1, 2011.

All New Students require:

- Health Inventory (Preschool & Kindergarten) or Health Assessment (Grades 1-12)
- Immunization Certificate

All Children between the ages of 2 and 5

- *A Parent's Guide to Regulated Child Care* must be signed and returned for your child's file. If you completed this in previous years you do not need to redo this.

All Children's Garden children require:

- Lead Screening Addendum (all children under 6 years)

All First Grade Students require:

- Health Assessment (completed within 6 months of the child entering First Grade)

All Upper School Students require:

- Annual Medical Statement (due by August 1)

Note to Returning Families: Even though we have your child's immunization records on file, we must have a record of any new immunizations received; this can be noted on a prescription slip. A new physical is not required unless entering 1st grade.

Emergency Form: A new emergency form must be completed **each year in full for each student.** This form remains in the file and is extremely important in case of emergency or illness. The Office must be notified of any changes immediately.

Medication Administration Authorization Form: This form must be completed by your child's physician if your child requires medication during the school day (prescription, homeopathic, over the counter).
