ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF SUBSTANCE USE POLICY

I/we understand and will support the school's substance use policy:

We expect, and our curriculum demands, that student be in full, clear consciousness at all times while enrolled at W/SB. The school expects that students will not possess, use or be under the influence of illicit drugs or alcoholic beverages at any time in or out of school, on or off of school premises. Any student who does not meet this expectation may be subject to disciplinary action, up to and including dismissal from the school.

The school prohibits any possession and/or use of tobacco products, illicit drugs and alcoholic beverages at any school event or on any school-related excursion. Furthermore, students may not be under the influence of alcohol or illicit drugs at any school event or on any school-related excursion. Any student who violates these rules will be subject to disciplinary action, up to and including dismissal from the school.

The level of investigation and subsequent action taken by the school will be determined in part by, but will not be limited to, the circumstances and degree to which any possible or confirmed violation of the school's substance abuse policy involved the school, its students and/or its resources. The school may seek assistance from law enforcement as it deems necessary and appropriate. If the faculty's observations of a student lead to concern that she or he may be breaking the law or the school's expectations and rules with regard to tobacco, alcohol or drugs, the school will contact the student's parents. The school may request or require laboratory testing as a condition of enrollment in cases of suspected or confirmed drug use or possession.

Each student, along with a parent, signs an acknowledgement of the school's substance abuse policy at the beginning of each school year. We expect students and families to demonstrate compliance with and support of this policy.
