



## After School Sports Teacher/Coach

**General Description of Post:** The After School Sports Teacher/Coach provides opportunities for middle school students to develop their skills in coed sports, to include: soccer in the fall, basketball in the winter, and a variety of different intramural sports in the spring, shifting to track and field as the weather warms. This position helps to build their collaboration, sportsmanship, and leadership skills, while fostering social engagement and fun. This position is part-time, hours are generally 3:15-5:15pm, which works well with many college student schedules. Hours may change slightly during games and meets with other schools.

**Authority:** The After School Sports Teacher/Coach has the authority to:

1. Deliver sports games and coaching to middle school students
2. Maintain classroom management of students with direction from the Physical Education Teacher and Academic Director
3. Maintaining the environment and equipment
4. Transporting students to off-site game locations
5. Communicate with Physical Education Teacher, Academic Director, and parents to ensure an integrated experience for each student.

### **General other duties and expectations:**

1. Adherence to school procedures and policies, as described in the Faculty Handbook, at all times.
2. Attending work weeks in June and August.
3. Arranging for a substitute<sup>1</sup> when there is a planned absence, and informing the Physical Education Teacher, Academic Director, and the office immediately in the event of an unplanned or emergency absence.

### **Attitude and motivation:**

1. Developing collegueship with all fellow teachers and staff.
2. Working with empathy and cultivating a sense for the higher self of each child, student, parent, and colleague in the school.
3. Familiarizing and/or deepening an understanding of the Waldorf program and anthroposophy.

**Accountability (supported by and reports to):** This position reports to and receives support from the Physical Education Teacher and the Academic Director.

**Belongs to:** the Elementary division, attending Full Faculty meetings.
